Fascism between historical truth and political representation.

From the dominance of “anti-fascist paradigm” to the interpretation of Fascism proposed by Renzo De Felice, Gustavo Corni reconstructs the evolution of contemporary historiography from 1945 until today.

His analysis puts the spotlight on issues such as the Resistance, the consensus for the fascist regime, the relations between the regime and strong economic powers. After the end of the so-called “First Republic”, anti-fascist paradigm has suffered blows even harder, in a radically changed political and cultural climate. The revisionists are on the agenda, provoking controversy but also strong support in public.

Gustavo Corni teaches Contemporary History at the University of Trento. Among his publications include: *Popoli in movimento* (2009).
