

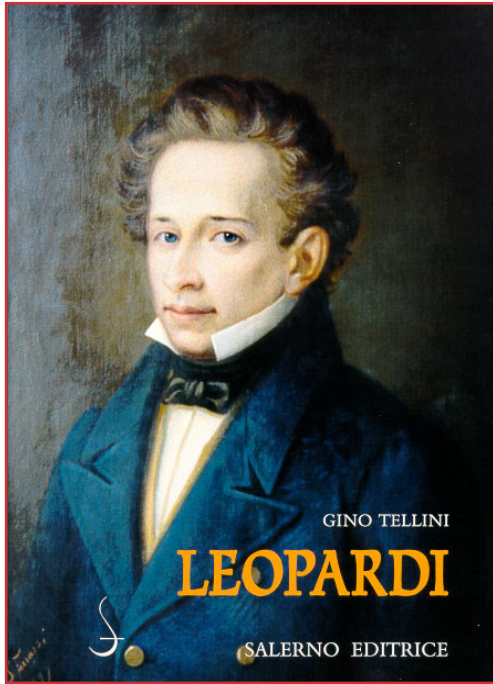
LEOPARDI

The real profile of Giacomo Leopardi (1798-1837) defies any attempt at easy definition: a poet of pessimism and pain? Cantor of negation and the existential void? This monograph answers the need for a rethinking in an organic way, of his shape, in the light of the most important contributions of recent studies. Multifforme and unsystematic writer, Leopardi finds its most characteristic style in an activity prodigiously prismatic, which Tellini follows with his elegant touch in all his expressions: from the poet, to the prose writer and diarist - and even to philosopher, scholar, translator.

Therefore a biography that, thanks to a very careful and original reconstruction of the poet - rich of facts, experiences and persons - adds important new details to the image of Leopardi, man and thinker.
