On the occasion of the 500th anniversary of the *Principe* a new political and intellectual biography of Machiavelli. Nowadays reading Machiavelli is a strong experience, as his genius has revealed, new and unexpected characteristic of our politics, that is always necessary to deal with. The Machiavellian politics is the searching for a common good, expressed in laws, not for a profit of the individual, but for the *res publica*. To realize his idea, Machiavelli doesn't shy away even from the most dramatic and hazardous hypothesis such as the one of principality.
