## The moral frontier of the West.

Left and Israel: two words that today are difficult to understand for our culture; in fact they are often subject of much misunderstandings, stereotypes, prejudices, controversies and resentments. Hardly anyone remembers that Carlo Marx was Jew and that many Russian revolutionaries were Jews.

Fabio Nicolucci argues that Israel is undoubtedly part of the West and it is the West of the West. In this sense it is impossible denying a common identity. In particular, the author focuses on the relationship of Israel and the left with the West: as regards Israel, Nicolucci presents an unpublished study of the relations between the U.S. and Israeli neoconservatives, while on the front of the left, he proposes a non diplomatic analysis of its vices, problems and relations with Israel. At the end the author shows how Israel could find again its ability to replace itself in the new world, that of the post-September 11.
