



**Una tragedia imperiale** - The rebellion of Henry, king of Germany, against his father, Emperor Frederick II, ended with his conviction to the prison, during which, devoured by leprosy, miserably ended up his short life. The story evokes all the mythological tragedy of the parent-child relationship, but also – historically more important - the inextricable complexity of the political conflict in the autumn of the Middle Ages, around the roles of the Empire, of monarchies, the feudalism and autonomous towns.
