## Lectures for the holidays

Let's close with two books, because every now and then it's important to talk about books and it was a bit that we weren't doing. They are very different from each other, but both of them report to a fundamental idea for environmentalist thought. That of complexity.

The first is *Ecologist a chi?* by Roberto Della Seta (Salerno Editrice). It is a book that starts from an interconnection that is so evident that it has been interpreted often in a somewhat arbitrary way: that between environment and pandemic.

Della Seta sidesteps, avoiding them, the two opposite readings that can be given in merit to the relationship between humans and nature at the time of Covid-19 (the nature that attacks us Vs we have attacked her) in order to try to put a bit of order, with passion and rationality.

Della Seta was president of Legambiente and was one of the fathers of the thought and the action of environmentalism in Italy. He will present the book in Rome, at Pi1 Libri Liberi, in the Sala Luna, on December 5th at 17.30, in a debate with Nicola Zingaretti, Ermete Realacci and the journalist of Domani Daniela Preziosi.
